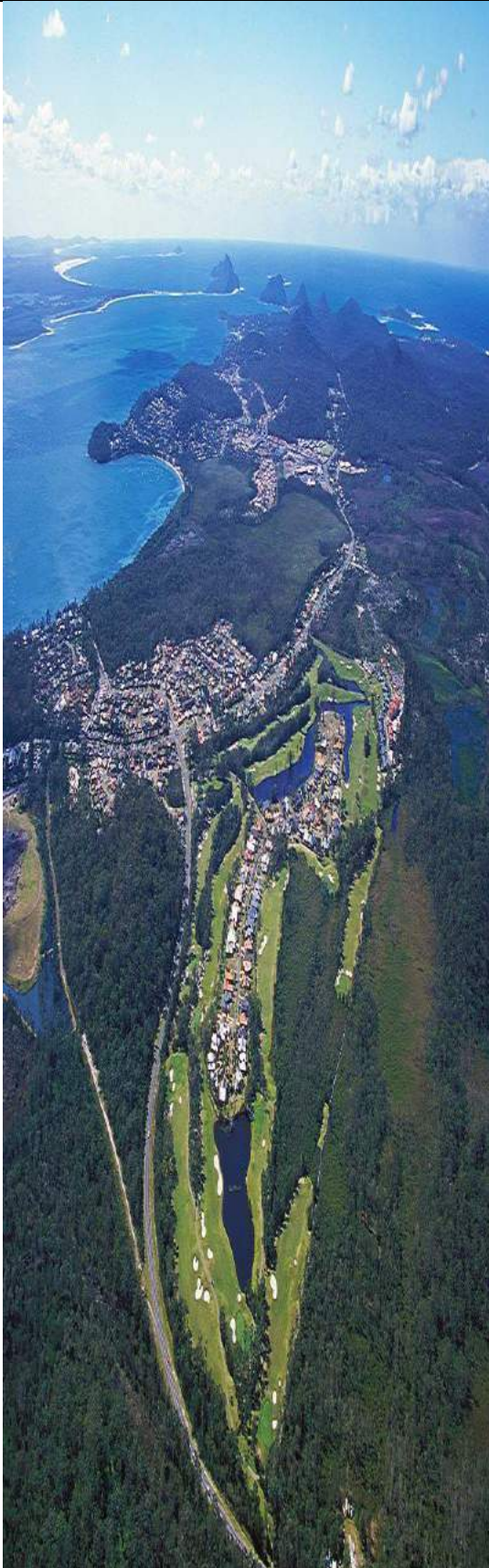

The Real Futures Foundation is a charitable Foundation unique to Port Stephens, founded in 2002 when the schools and business communities of the Tomaree Peninsula realised that there was a need for a focused approach to assist youth in the transition from education to employment. The very geography of our region which makes it a desirable retirement and seasonal holiday destination isolates youth and provides little opportunity for a rewarding career. The Foundation has created a unique set of programs aimed at assisting those young people most at risk of becoming disengaged from the education system or unemployed upon leaving school. The programs which we offer are tailored to individual students' needs.

The involvement of the business community in funding programs, and local business leaders facilitating mentoring and mock interview sessions with youth is key to the unique opportunity the programs offer. Some of our successes include students that have participated in mock-interviews gaining employment in their chosen field after impressing business participants during the program, and students undertaking a year-long work experience program subsequently working in their chosen industry for more than five years.

The Foundation funds a range of programs, including Skill-IT (skills industry training in a range of fields including hospitality), Intensive Training Programs such as the Brick and Block Layers Building Program, The WesTrac Institute Heavy Mechanics Up Skill Program, Work Ready Programs, Careers Expo's, Group Assessment Skills Workshops, Work Experience and individualised programs to meet the needs of our local young people. Each student that participates in our programs has been identified as needing extra help and support to succeed in the transition from school to education. Work Ready Programs equip students with White Cards, First Aid Certificates and mentoring which assists students in determining the type of careers which their talents may best suit.
